V. OTHER BUSINES

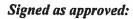
a. Discussion of Land Use Ordinance amendments to the Design Review Board overlay district.

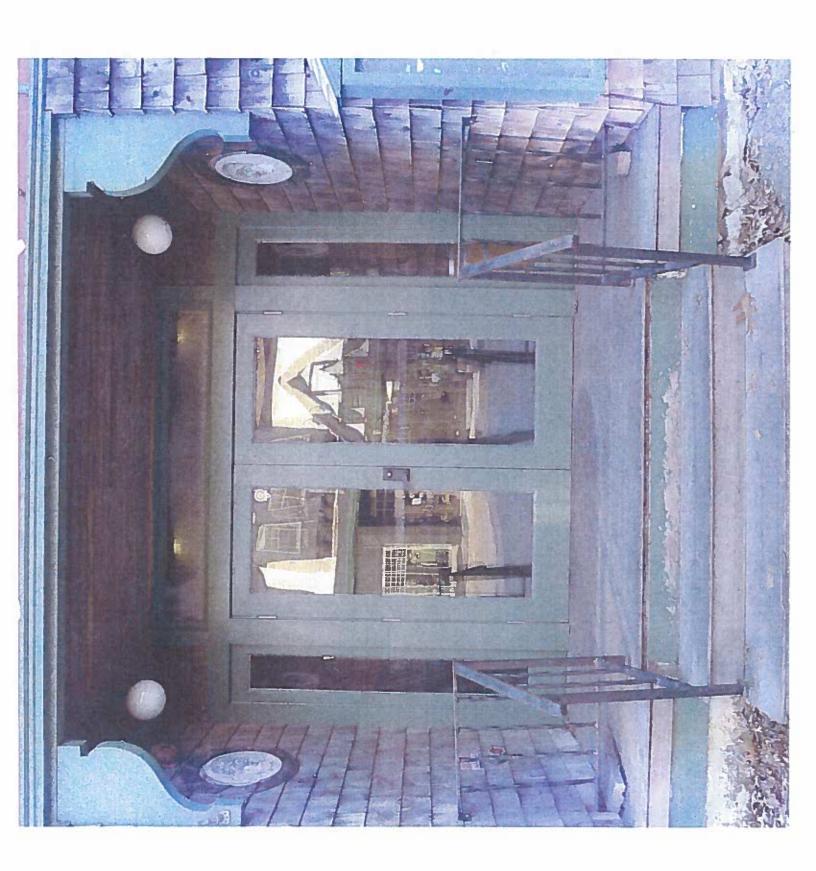

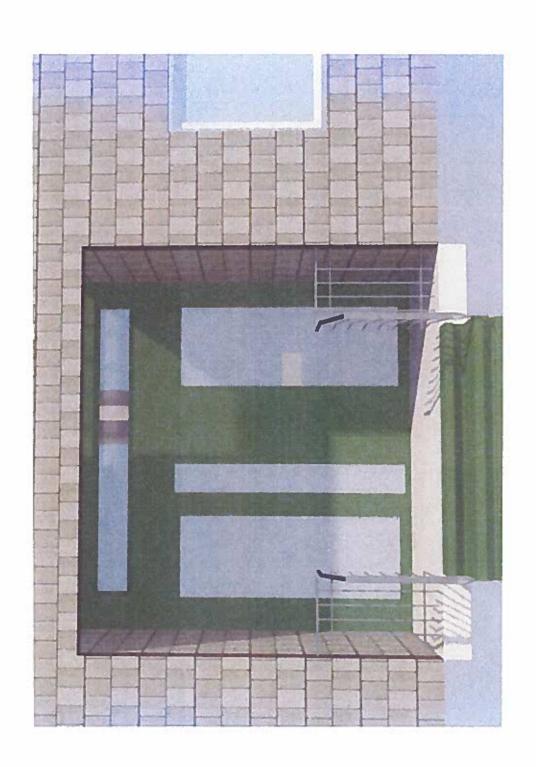

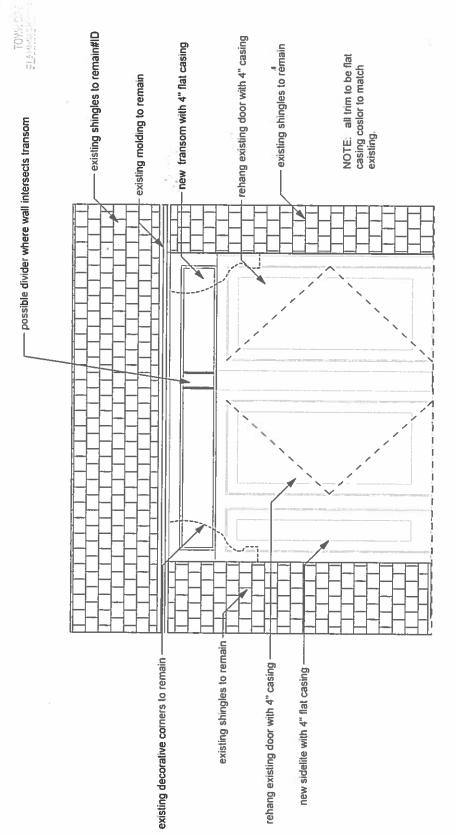

Detailed Project Description:

This project was issued a Certificate of Appropriateness January 11, 2018. This application seeks to amend that certificate in the following ways:

- 1. The new front entry doors, sidelights and transoms will be clear anodized aluminum instead of dark blue;
- 2. The two windows located above the entry doors will be clear anodized aluminum instead of anodized bronze;
- The existing yellow brick wall section facing Main Street will receive brick veneer and mortar to match the masonry on the original bank structure facing Main Street as closely as possiblem, instead of being stained
 The rest of the project will remain as approved.

The use of clear anodized aluminum frames will complement the gray color of the FRC panels in the same section of the facade, and strengthen the visual separation between the original bank facade and the blank masonry facade section built in the 1960s.

The drawings shall provide information on the various building details covered in the standards, such as roofing materials, siding, windows, doorways, detailing and trim, etc. Details of all exterior materials, including type, color, and composition. Paint chips or product samples shall be provided for each proposed use. Details on the design, color, and location of lighting fixtures together with information on proposed lighting levels shall be provided for new exterior lighting or changes in exterior lighting seen from a public street.
