# Vehicles and Traffic Ordinance Amendment

Town of Bar Harbor

#2019-07

**An Amendment to clarify several streets where parking is prohibited and a one way street.**

*The Town of Bar Harbor hereby ordains that Chapter 194, Vehicles and Traffic, of the Town Code is amended as follows:*

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## CHAPTER 194 – VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

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### § 194-14 **Parking prohibited at all times on certain streets.**

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B. Designated areas. Parking shall be prohibited at all times upon the following streets or parts thereof:

<b>Name of Street</b>	<b>Location</b>
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Des Isle Avenue	<del>Both sides</del> <u>East side and 30 feet from each end on the west side.</u>
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Greeley Square	Left side from southern intersection with Greeley Avenue
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<u>Hancock Street</u>	<u>North side</u>
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High Street	West side
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Snow Street	West side
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<del>Spring Lane</del>	<del>Both sides</del>
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<u>Spring Street</u>	<u>West side and on the east side from the intersection with Mount Desert Street south for 273 feet.</u>
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Stanwood Place	South side
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### § 194-34 **One-way streets.**

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B. Designation of one-way streets. Upon the following streets or parts thereof, traffic shall move only in the following specified direction:

<b>Name of Street</b>	<b>Direction</b>
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<u>Des Isle Avenue</u>	<u>North</u>
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Everard Court	South
