Re: Special Council Meeting March 22<sup>nd</sup> at 7 pm.

As required under the Town Charter section C-31 sec.(I), the Council shall review the recommendations of the Warrant Committee and submit the budget to Town Meeting with or without changes. The only differences between the two budgets are the Broadband Engineering in the CIP \$50,000 and the \$30,000 (from Cruise Ship Fund Balance) HUB request. The Cruise Ship Committee voted 8-4 to recommend the request not be funded.

Enclosed is a sheet showing the amount needed from property taxes between the two proposals. Possible Motion: to recommend to Town Meeting the FY 2017 budget as proposed with the net property tax assessment at \$16,033,371 (or the Warrant Committee recommended amount of \$15,983,371).

Even though the HUB request does not affect the amount raised by taxation there should be a reconciliation discussion. Possible motion: To (not) include the HUB's request of \$30,000 in the FY 2017 budget.
