I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 AM. Members present: Chair Sandy McFarland, Jeff Miller, Matt Bartlett, Jim Willis, Chip Reeves and Jocelyn McLean, Secretary.

II. ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA

Mr. Reeves, with second by Mr. Willis, moved to adopt the agenda as presented. Motion passed 5-0.

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – July 11, 2018

Mr. Willis, with second by Mr. Miller, moved to approve the minutes of July 11, 2018 as presented. Motion passed 5-0.

IV. REGULAR BUSINESS

a. Curb Cut Application

Andrew Shea summarized his request for a curb cut at 41 Hancock Street.

Mr. Bartlett, with second by Mr. Willis, moved to approve application PT-2019-01 for a 15' curb cut on Hancock Street. Motion passed 5-0. The approved application will go to Council March 5, 2019.

b. Criterion Theatre Request for Bump Out

Amy Roeder, Executive Director, Mark Tipton, Development Director, Michael Boland, Board Member, and Ed Libitzki of Metal Magic were present representing the Criterion. Matt Hochman also spoke to this issue.

Topics of discussion included:

- Cost to the Criterion of repairs and insurance for the marquee due to multiple hits
- The handicap spaces as approved by Council (possibly relocating; non ADA compliance; illegal use by delivery vehicles and RV's; etc.)
- Current use of stanchions; temporary, moveable, on loan from Police Department
- Cottage St. Streetscape plan
- New parking meter system

The consensus was to seek a temporary solution.

Mr. Reeves, with second by Mr. Bartlett, motioned to move forward with the LARK Studio design for a bump out in front of the Criterion and work with the Criterion on a cost-share agreement to get something implemented in the Spring. Motion passed 5-0. The recommendation will go to Council March 19, 2019.
