  - A. **Dobbs' Productions Request for Use of "P" channel:** This is Jeff Dobbs annual request for use of the Town's public access channel (now located on Spectrum's channel 1301) for the summer of 2019 and also in the fall and winter of 2019/2020 for related *The Acadia Channel* programming to include the bulletin board, Christmas concerts, exercise, local health, educational and information programming, as highlighted in the Dobbs letter of 4/19/19.
- 6) **Public Comment:** There were no comments from the public. However, Steve did solicit member opinions on the options being considered for upgrading the internet speeds being funded by the Cruise Ship budget for the public access in Agamont and Village Green parks.
- 7) **Items for Next meeting:** There is not a meeting scheduled at this time
