A. Harbor Committee role and responsibilities in Ferry Terminal future uses:

The town voted June 12, 2018 to buy the old ferry terminal property. Harbormaster Charlie Phippen reported that the Ferry Terminal Steering Committee had met and that the Harbor Committee will have a role in the planning process for the property. Details of that role will be forth coming. The Cat Ferry will make a proposal to Town Council on July 17, 2018 for a possible return to ferry service in Bar Harbor.

NEW BUSINESS:

A. Harborview Park:

The remaining Harborview Park CIP funds of approximately \$20,000 will be used for railing at Harborview Park that will look much like the railing on the town pier. Recently completed renovations to the park were funded by Ocean Properties. The committee wishes to continue improvements to the park that would include access to the water.
