Volunteer Firefighting has long been part of Bar Harbor's history. The Bar Harbor Fire Department has seen a decline in volunteers, currently Bar Harbor has 13 Volunteer Firefighters that respond to calls in Bar Harbor.

The number of calls for Emergency Medical Services and Fire Services has increased from 1,462 calls in 2016 to 1,749 calls in 2017.

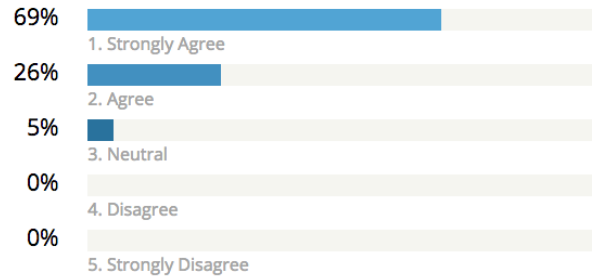
