APPROVAL OF MINUTES - May 2022 minutes – were approved 4-0.

### OLD BUSINESS:

A. Clam pamphlet. The committee went over the revised clam document and liked the changes and will forward the new pamphlet on to the town clerk.

B. Ordinance language change. The committee discussed the changes to the ordinance, and agreed to the general context of the changes. We are going to make sure these changes work with the state and then approve them as a committee and send them to the town. This will add both eastern oysters and quahogs to our ordinance when it is approved by DMR and passed by the town council.

C. Conservation closure language and vote. The committee discussed a possible shellfish closure at the Clark's Cove salt pond from May 15 – October 15. The committee voted and approved the closure. This ordinance change will now go to the town council, and Fiona agreed to be at the meeting to help answer any questions.

D. Signage at Hadley Point. We discuss the language John and Joanna came up with for the sign to post at Clarke's Cove. The next step will be working with Chris Wharff to get the information printed and posted.
